1. What is the EDB

EDB is a file composed of pictures and text unique to ClassIn.

 Compared with PPT, EDB supports arbitrarily dragging, painting and other operations on the courseware content.

- The size should be about 2MB, < 3MB.
- The blackboard courseware supports the sum of pictures of 30 million pixels at most. At present, the standard size of one page blackboard courseware in the classroom is 1280 pixels x590 pixels, and covering the pictures takes up about 760,000 pixels.
- The total number of images should not exceed 1.5 million pixels.


Tips

Step3. Enter "Preparation room"


Method 2: Blackboard editor



3.Lock


- Click the lock icon in the upper left corner of the picture to fix the picture.
- > The locked picture cannot be moved, deleted or changed. Click again to unlock.
- > This feature can prevent students from accidentally deleting.
- > The text does not support locking, you can convert it to a picture format before locking



4.Layer & Rotate


Layer: Ctrl+ left mouse button

Bring forward, Send backward, Bring to front, Send to back



Rotate: Ctrl+ left mouse button

Move the mouse to the corner of the picture (any one of the four corners) and a rotation icon will appear, just click it to rotate.
